- A completed Application for Monument Installation must be submitted and approved before work can commence.
- The works carried out must be as set out in the Application for Monument Installation Form.
- Renovations or repairs can only be carried out by a Monumental Mason with an Annual Licence issued by the City or the holder of a Single Monumental Work Permit.
- The wording of the original inscription cannot be altered or added on to and other works allowed are limited to minor repairs to existing monumental.
- The applicant for the work is to complete the attached Statutory Declaration stating he/she has the authority to repair/renovate the existing memorial on the gravesite.
- Requests for changes to inscriptions, new memorials or major changes to the monumental will require a new Grant of Right of Burial to be purchased.
- An administration fee of \$31 will apply per application.
