

Section 70A Notification Flow Chart

Section 70A is part of the *Transfer of Land Act 1893* that allows notifications to be placed on a property's Certificate of Title. This is done to ensure any current or future owners are aware of matters which may impact the enjoyment of that property.

It is the developer or landowners responsibility to undertake this process and pay for all associated cost with lodging the notification with Landgate.

The flow chart, below, gives an overview of the process, while the How-To Guide attached will help you navigate Landgate's website.

Go to Landgates website to fill in the notification electronically. (See How-To Guide)

Print double sided. Ensure all landowners have signed the form and it has been witnessed correctly.

Provide the original hardcopy to the City of Busselton.

The Mayor & CEO will sign - this can take over 1 week to complete.

The original, executed document will be provided back to you. Either by post, or made available for collection at the City Office.

Lodge the document with Landgate in person or by post. Fees apply.

Provide a copy of the Landgate lodgement receipt to the City. This will act as evidence that you have complied with the condition of approval.

5. Land Titling Forms – scroll down to **Record Interest** and select **Notification**



7. Registered Proprietor(s) (Land) – select Derive. This will pull through all the owners of the property.





8. Authorising Party – This is the City of Busselton. Select Add.

9. Execution Date – No change. Leave Blank.




10.Registered Proprietor(s) Land Execution – click Add



- Note: 1. Where land is owned by more than one person, you will need to repeat this step for each
 - 2. Land owned by a person will always be execution type

 A person representing themselves
 - 3. Land owned by company will be execution type A company with a Common Seal or, A Company without a Common Seal.




