## NO FIRES ON PUBLIC LAND INCLUDING BEACHES AT ANY TIME

- ✘ **Prohibited Burning Times 1 December to 28 February each year** (dates subject to change without notice).
- ✘ **No fires in the open** any time of the year when the **Fire Danger Rating is High or above** or when there is a **Total Fire Ban**.
- ✓ Gas BBQs and pizza ovens are **permitted**.

## HOW TO BE SAFE WHEN FIRES ARE PERMITTED

- ✓ Don't light a fire if the weather is hot, dry and windy.
- ✓ Before you light anything up - look around and think about the risk. A small fire is big enough!
- ✓ Ensure all vegetation and flammable materials are cleared at least 3m from around the fire site.
- ✓ Never leave your fire unattended and extinguish it with water before you leave.
